 - a. 7th Grade – 15minute halves
 - b. 8th Grade – 15 minute halves
 - c. 9th Grade – 20minute halves
3. Number in playing sides:
 - a. 7th Grade – 5 aside
 - b. 8th, 9th Grade – 8 aside
4. Starting Times:
 - a. 7th Grade – 11.15am
 - b. 8th Grade – 10.15am
 - c. 9th Grade – 9.00am
5. Numbers in squads:
 - a. 7th Grade – 6/7 players
 - b. 8th Grade – 9/10 players
 - c. 9th Grade – 9/10 players
6. Rules and Regulations are as follows:
 - a. 7th Grade:
 - i. Size 3 Ball
 - ii. 5 aside
 - iii. 15 minute halves
 - iv. 3-5 minutes break
 - v. No Goal keepers
 - vi. Half junior Pitch
 - vii. Target goals, or cones used as goals - 3 strides (yards) apart
 - viii. No throws ins (pass in)
 - ix. No corner kicks
 - x. Goal kick from 6 yard box
 - xi. Opponents retire to half way for goal kicks
 - xii. No off sides
 - xiii. Rolling subs
 - xiv. Goals scored from attacking half only
 - xv. Coach can assist from own half of pitch

- b. 8th, 9th Grade:
- i. Size 3 ball
 - ii. 8 aside
 - iii. 15 minute halves (8th grade only)
 - iv. 20 minute halves (9th grade only)
 - v. 5 minutes for break (8th, 9th grades)
 - vi. Corner kicks from midway 12 yard and corner
 - vii. Goal kicks from 12 yard box
 - viii. Offside rule will be applied and explained
 - ix. Normal throw ins
 - x. Rolling subs
 - xi. Goalie
 - xii. Played on a junior size pitch
 - xiii. There are to be x2 referees per game. Each referee will ref a half of the game (e.g. 9th Grade - 20minuts each). While refereeing, you are allowed to coach on the field for both grades. If a foul has been committed by a player e.g. offside, then the referee is to pull up this foul and award the free kick for the other side. Make sure that the referee stops play and explains the offside rule to the player that made the foul. Another Example; If a player commits a foul throw then give the player another chance to perform this action but explain what s/he did wrong (so the player knows and understands). If the player commits the same foul then the foul throw is turned over to the opposition.
 1. 8th Grade – the opposing coach is allowed on the pitch to help his/her team while the game is being played but not refereeing.
 2. 9th Grade - the opposing coach can coach from the side line.

7. Draw:

- a. For all athletes within this 7th, 8th, 9th Grade the Draw (including all starting times, ground etc) will be posted on the Cashmere Wanderers Web site.
