Hello to Coaches, Managers, Parents and Players

We are holding the race on the Heathcote River, starting at Emlea Tce and finishing by the Cashmere Club entrance, with winners announced at 4pm in the Cashmere Club (you do not need to be present to win).

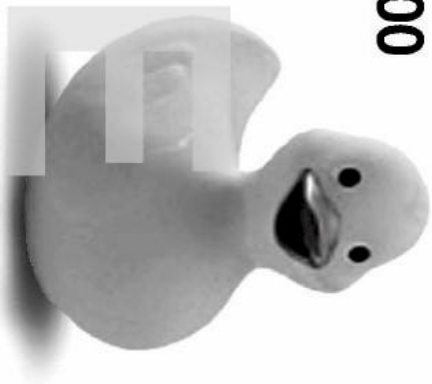

Duck Race Rules

- Each Duck Adoption Ticket sold, will relate to a numbered duck in the race.
- All Adoption forms must be received by race Organisers by 1.00pm on race day to ensure they will be in the race.
- Ducks may be Adopted for a donation of \$ 5.00 to Cashmere Wanderers AFC, an Incorporated Society.
- Ducks will be launched from a bag, slung from a crane, in Erniea Tce at approximately 2pm on Sunday 12th June 2005 and will be raced on the Heathcote river.
- The course will finish approximately 100 metres before the Malcolm Ave bridge.
- Once the ducks are launched, they are on their own. **No attempt to free or interfere with any duck is permitted.**
- Winning ducks will be identified in the order they enter the finishing chute.
- The persons name who appears on the Adoption receipt corresponding to the winning ducks will be awarded prizes. Positive identification will be required to claim prizes. Prizes not claimed within 90 days will be forfeited.
- In the event of the race being unable to be run, winners will be determined by Lottery, with the Winners Draw, being undertaken at 4pm on Sunday 12th June 2005 at the Cashmere Club, Hunter Tce, Christchurch.
- Winners will be announced at 4pm on Sunday 12th June 2005 at the Cashmere Club, Hunter Tce, Christchurch, with a Public Notice in The Press on Wednesday 15th June 2005. Winners will also be personally contacted via the contact details provided on the Adoption ticket.
- Chances of winning depend on the total number of qualified entries, with a maximum of 4,999 ducks entered.
- All decisions and interpretations of these rules will be made by the Organising Committee.
